Top 10 Requirements for AI-Consumable APIs

1

Good Documentation

Documentation is now a first class citizen. Leverage well-defined specifications such as OpenAPI to their fullest - including examples, summaries, error codes, and descriptions - to ensure AI agents and developers can both understand your APIs.

Centralize to Strategize: One Catalog for All Your APIs

Use a vendor neutral catalog with lifecycle capabilities to get all your APIs in one place, prioritize the ones you want to enhance, and manage the process of enhancement and consumption. AI-readiness requires new lifecycle stages and promotion criteria. Not every API is ready for automation.

Two Views, One API: Prevent Portfolio Sprawl

To avoid more API chaos, it is preferable to have two consumer views of the API documentation and metadata rather than to create and manage two different API portfolios. One API, tailored experiences for agents and developers.

AI-Enhanced Documentation —Securely and Smartly

Use GenAI to help accelerate the API documentation enhancement, but make sure the process is well managed and secure. For example, you may want to automatically redact sensitive elements of your APIs before giving them to an AI augmentation engine. Consider standardizing your prompts to GenAI engines for enhancements, and also factor in the associated costs of using these tools.

Agentic Gateways? Portals? Stay Flexible.

The jury is out on whether you need a separate Agentic AI gateway instance and / or a separate Agentic AI portal. Keep your options open and start experimenting and learning. Composing capabilities, not just endpoints, with the right catalog connected to your gateways and epos, this should be easy and flexible.

Governance Matters More with AI Agents

Governance and adherence to your enterprise API compliance standards is even more critical with Agentic AI consumption. Get something wrong and you can't revoke it once the LLMs have digested it! Make sure governance is built into your API development process, ideally in a way that minimizes friction.

Enable Controlled Exposure

Segment what internal copilots can use versus external agents.

Start Small, Scale Smart: Equip an Expert API Task Force

Start with a small expert team leveraging powerful productivity tooling that can automate the enhancement, governance, and lifecycle of your APIs – don't hand off manual work to your developers.

Control Agentic Costs: Monitor Usage from Day One

To avoid runaway costs, shadow integrations, and support issues build in the ability to track and audit agentic AI usage of your APIs.

Don't Wait for Standards— Future-Proof While Moving Fast

This space is fast moving and standards like MCP and A2A are developing but not fast enough to wait for. Pick tooling that makes sure you don't get left behind but that also has the flexibility to pivot later without legacy drag.
